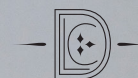

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VINEYARD

Memorious is 3.5 acre parcel planted immediately downslope from Bloom's Field. The clay at Memorious is dark and rich. The grapes grown here have thicker skins. The vineyard tilts to the south and west, giving it a direct view to the Pacific Ocean. It is often the last vineyard we harvest and the wine is always our most structured, saturated, and pigmented. Memorious is named for the one acre of seedlings planted along the western edge of the vineyard. From these seedlings our hope is to one day cultivate and produce Pinot Noir from our own genetic selection that will be the next generation of uncloned Pinot Noir.

TASTING NOTE

Memorious reveals a new dimension in the 2015 vintage, signaling for the first time its close kinship with Bloom's Field. To date, the sites yielded remarkably different wines considering their proximity. As the lower of the two sites, Memorious has always shown the fleshiness and primary fruit indicative of its clay-rich topsoil, but in 2015 we encounter a more developed finish to a noticeably darker wine. This lengthening brings with it a discernible saline snap and a savory flourish. As the young roots work through the clay loam and into the ancient seabed below, the signature saltiness – previously exclusive to Bloom's Field – now emerges in a longer, more focused finish at Memorious.
